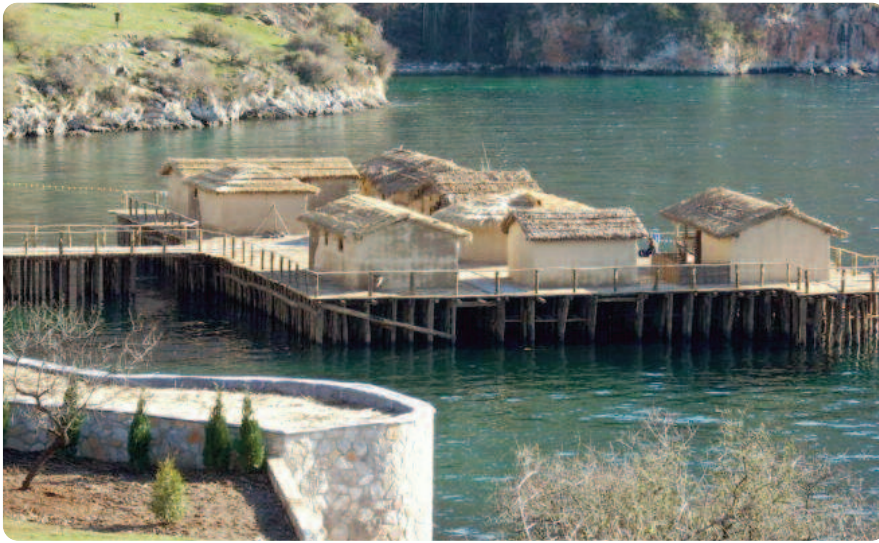

Oak supportive poles



Interesting Facts:

- **Reconstruction of a pre-historic settlement in Lake Ohrid, Macedonia.**
- **Uvix Impregnation treated around 660 cubic metres of oak poles with TANALITH E to support the settlement platforms.**
- **The oak poles replace what was believed to be 6000 original poles ranging between 13-30 cms in diameter.**
- **In the original settlement, dating between 3500 and 500BC, dwellings built of timber, straw and reeds were erected on the platforms reaching up to 300 metres from the shoreline.**
