Interesting Facts:

- **TANALISED** pressure treated timber used throughout a remote safari lodge in the South African bush.
- The construction includes interconnecting broad walks and timber decks, superbly blending the lodges with its beautiful, natural surroundings.
- Designed by André Serfontein – a specialist designer of other sophisticated safari camps within the Kruger National Park.
- Major construction materials include gum poles, pine and saligna for flooring and exterior decking. The interconnecting walkways were all produced with TANALISED treated pine.
